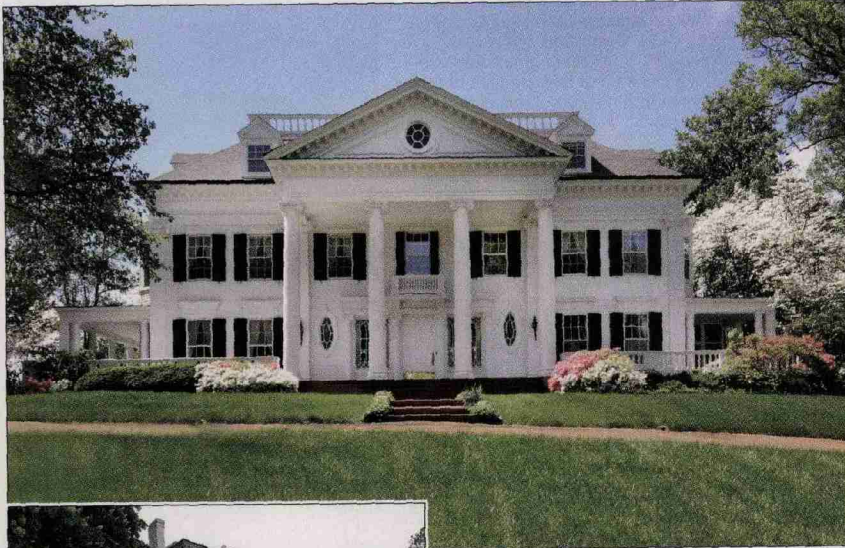
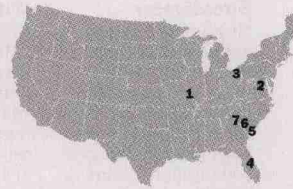

This week: Plantation-style homes



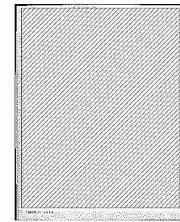
1 ▲ Ladue, Mo. This six-bedroom neoclassical-revival house, built in 1908, was inspired by the Southern states' exhibit at the 1904 St. Louis World's Fair. The home features a central grand salon and other large-scale rooms with period architectural details. 4 ▲ Winter Springs, Fla. This 10-year-old, seven-bedroom estate features two formal outdoor fountains and a private boathouse on Lake Jessup. Interior details include a grand dual central stairway, mural-covered ceilings, several crystal chandeliers, and a library with floor-to-ceiling built-in shelves. \$2,750,000. 6 ▲ Edgefield, S.C. Mulberry Hill Plantation's porches overlook acres of orchards in the heart of South Carolina's peach country. A road lined with pecan trees leads to the five-bedroom house, which has 12-foot ceilings, hand-hewn pine floors, fireplaces in most rooms, and an attached indoor swimming pool. \$775,000. 5 ▲ St. Helena Island, S.C. One of the few surviving antebellum plantation houses on St. Helena Island, Tombee Plantation, built in 1795, sits on 20 acres along Station Creek.
