Utility assistance

The North East Community Action Corporation will take applications from income-qualifying families and individuals starting Nov. 1 for winter utility assistance.

Applications for the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) also will continue to be accepted from the elderly and disabled.

Eligibility is based upon income, the number of people per household and the type of heating source. LIHEAP is funded by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and distributed through the Missouri Department of Social Services to non-profit groups such as NECAC. The program pays part of the utility bills of income-qualifying people.

NECAC will begin mailing applications Oct. 31 to families and individuals served by the program last year in the agency's 12-county service region. Applications will be accepted by mail and in person from 8 a.m. - 5 p.m. weekdays at NECAC's St. Charles County Service Center, 3400 Meadow Pointe Drive in O'Fallon.
